Did You Know ... Origins of Mother's Day:

Honoring mother's, dates back to the Greeks and Romans honoring mother goddesses, Rhea and Cybele. Modern Mother's Day stems from "Mothering Sunday," when faithful Christians in England and Europe would return to their "Mother Church" (home church) for a special service. Anna Jarvis organized the first Mother's Day in the U.S. in honor of her mother, to commemorate the sacrifices mothers made for their children. However, Jarvis despised the growing commercialism and by her death in 1948, she had disowned the holiday altogether! So today, let us just honor our mothers!
